## VISITOR INFORMATION

This link has some info on hotels. The Best Western Plus, Rodeway Inn, and Millennium Harvest House are easy walking distance. Homewood Suites and Hilton Garden Inn are a little further.

To summarize getting to the meeting.

\*If you have a DoD CAC card, you do not need to be issued a visitor's badge. Just proceed to the right vehicle entrance lane and show your badge. If you are walking instead of driving, no need to show the CAC card, just proceed to the entrance of DSRC.

\*If you do not have a CAC card, you need a visitor's badge which is issued at the Visitor's center (small building in the entrance parking lot). We have sent a list of names to the security staff and they should be expecting you.

- Visitors are required to sign in and receive a visitor badge from the Visitors Center.
- Visitors to the site who are U.S. citizens must present a U.S. photo ID, such as a current state driver's license or passport. [If you are from the State of Washington, advise you to bring passport]
- Foreign Nationals who are <u>permanent residents</u> must present a valid **passport with** their permanent resident ID ("green card").

\*After you receive your badge, proceed through the gate and turn left into the big parking lot. Park your car and walk down to the main entrance to DSRC. If you don't have a car, just walk into the main entrance. There you present your badge, tell them you are attending a conference in 1D403, sign in (again). Head to the conference room.
